Bach composed the cantata in Leipzig for the feast of St. Michael and first performed on 29 September 1728 or 1729. The prescribed readings for the day were Revelation 12, verses 7–12, and Matthew 18, verses 1–11. The work draws on text from Psalm 118, verses 15–16, and the third stanza of Martin Schalling's chorale Herzl... (more online)
