Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750)
BWV Anh. 126

Sheet music for Musette by Johann Sebastian Bach, BWV Anh. 126. The music is for two voices (treble and bass) in 2/4 time, A major (three sharps). The score consists of four systems of music.
